The Hawaii Certified Peer Specialist (HCPS) program trains mental health consumers to model recovery skills to their peers. In a research study conducted by Optum in New York, behavioral health costs were reduced 47% with the use of certified peer specialists. In this training, we will hear from three professionals collaborating through their roles to provide effective certified peer specialist services to consumers on Oahu and how these services have enhanced the lives of people recovering from mental illness.
